# TECH CENTER WIRING UPDATE by Richard Ravich

The HOA has contracted with ELB, a company specializing in wiring spaces to best take advantage of technology, to perform rewiring work in SCPD. The Technology Center is included! Over the summer Kathryn Querry and I have been meeting with Brian Locke (HOA Information Systems & Communications Director), and representatives from ELB, to discuss ideas for reconfiguring the Technology Center's infrastructure. Here is a brief rundown of what will be completed soon:

- Our internet speed has been upgraded from 200 Megabits per second to 2,000 Megabits per second. This will increase the response time when using our computers to access the internet.
- Rewired ethernet cabling will allow us to make use of the speed increase. The old cabling, probably installed twenty years ago, is not capable of handling the increased speeds. Plus, instead of having unsightly cable bundles along the floor, there will be new cable enclosures for a neater look.
- HDMI ports will be added to the front of the classroom to accommodate those instructors who prefer to teach from the front. The ability to teach from the instructor PC and MAC in the back of the classroom remains, providing instructors with a choice.
- You will also see a new equipment rack on the window counter, which contains our new stuff.

If you are interested in understanding how all of this equipment works, contact me and I'll be glad to show you.
